



## What is ProQuest?

ProQuest is a website providing access to multiple databases of scholarly content, including journals, books, videos, dissertations, newspapers, and more. Students at Ascent College will regularly use ProQuest to curate academically appropriate sources for theological research and theses development as assigned by faculty.

## Do I have to pay for ProQuest?

No. Ascent College has an institutional license to ProQuest, allowing students and faculty access to all ProQuest databases during their time at Ascent College.

**\*NOTE:** *ProQuest is easiest to access using a desktop or laptop computer.*

## STEP ONE

Log in to your Ascent.edu email address via [mail.google.com](mailto:mail.google.com). (If you are already signed in, you may need to log out and back in again to ensure full access to Google Workspace functionality.)

## STEP TWO

Click on “Students” in the header menu and select “MyAscent” in the dropdown menu.

Scroll down to Research Tools on the left side and select “Proquest Database.” This will open a new window or tab.

Google may automatically prompt a connection to your Ascent email account, or you may be asked to manually log in. Your username is your Ascent.edu email address.

Your password is the same password you use to log in to your Ascent.edu email account.

Once you log in, you will be redirected to the ProQuest database search page.
